Frequently Asked Questions - Receptions

What is included in the price?

- * Our beautiful Manor Oaks House venue presented for you with tables, chairs, white tablecloths, rustic centre pieces and a cake stand.
- * Our fully stocked bottle bar
- * Our professional bar team ready to welcome and serve you.
- * All our fairy lights to make the day sparkle!
- * Access to Manor Oaks House from 9am on the morning of your wedding for you, your family, or suppliers to add any personal touches to the room.
- * Use of our stone fire pit, including firewood.
- * Use of our garden games for your guests to enjoy.
- * A pre-wedding meeting with our in-house wedding co-ordinator before your wedding.
- * Our wedding team on site to oversee the event.
- * Outdoor electrical facilities to accommodate outdoors caterers such as food trucks and pizza ovens.



What wedding breakfast options do you have available?

Our highly acclaimed onsite caterers The Rhubarb Shed Café can provide you a delicious wedding breakfast. They have many different offers including, sit-down meals, buffets, and BBQs. Your wedding breakfast is not included in the price and will need to be organised directly with the rhubarb shed. Can we use an external caterer?

You are more than welcome to use external caterers. Please do be aware only the Rhubarb Shed are allowed access to the kitchen, so caterers would need to be able to cook offsite or outside. We have an outdoor electricity source to allow for you to be served fresh evening food such as, pizzas and hog roasts.

How do we play music inside the venue?

We have Bluetooth speakers which you are welcome to connect to and use during your ceremony and meal for background music. We recommend hiring a DJ, band, or PA system to play music during your evening reception.

When are last orders and departure times?



On Saturdays you have until 12am to depart, the bar will close at 11:30pm, and all music should be off by this time also. Tuesday to Friday you have until 11pm to depart with music and drinks ceasing at 10:30pm. We recommend letting your guests know our finishing times so they can pre-book taxis.

How many guests can we invite to the wedding breakfast and the reception?

If you get married in Manor Oaks House, you can have up to 60 guests for your wedding breakfast. If you get married on the Turret House grounds or off-site you can have to 100 guests. For your evening reception we can host up to 120 guests.

Do you provide cutlery, crockery, and glassware?

We provide all glassware. Crockery and cutlery are to be provided by your caterers.

Can we have our own décor for our reception?

Yes. We provide a simple, rustic setup for your wedding, using white table linen and centre pieces, which you have the choice to use. You are welcome to decorate the venue further to add your own personal touch to your day. Access to Manor Oaks



House is given from 9am on the day of your wedding, to you, your family, and suppliers.

Can we use candles?

We allow use of LED candles only.

Do you allow fireworks?

To protect our wildlife, we do not allow any fireworks onsite. However, we do permit sparklers to be used around the firepit.

Can we leave our decorations at the venue?

Decorations can be left at Manor Oaks house after your wedding. We give couples who are getting married on Friday and Saturday access to collect any décor on Sundays between 10am and 1pm. Couples getting married midweek will be given a collection

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time for the day after their wedding. After this time any items remaining on site will be disposed of. If you are having your ceremony at the Turret House, any items will need to be brought by you or your guests to Manor Oaks House after the ceremony. Please note we cannot store any large or sentimental items on site.



Are we allowed to smoke on site?

Smoking and vaping are not allowed inside any of our venues. We will provide a designated outdoor smoking area with sand buckets for the safe disposal of cigarette ends at Manor Oaks House.

Are there toilet facilities at the venue?

There are toilets in Manor Oaks House including one accessible toilet with baby change facilities.

How do I book?

Once you have chosen your perfect wedding date, you will be sent our terms and conditions and a booking form to fill out. Once we have received your booking form, we will process your invoice. A deposit of £600 will be required within 10 working days of receiving your invoice to secure your date. Once we have received the deposit, we will be able to confirm your wedding with us.

How much is the deposit?

We require a non-refundable £600 deposit, which will be subtracted from the total cost of your wedding. 40 days before your wedding we will also require you to pay a £300 refundable damages deposit. This will be additional to the total cost of your wedding.



When is our final payment due? The final payment is due no later than 30 days before your wedding day. You can send your payments through in any instalments that suit you. Just remember to quote your invoice number when sending your payments.
