OVERALL PURPOSE OF JOB:

As a customer facing Landscape Manager you will form part of the landscape products and services team and be responsible for the establishment, maintenance, and delivery of high-quality planting including meadows, green roofs and Sustainable Urban Drainage Systems (SuDS) across the UK and occasionally into Europe. You will provide specialist knowledge and expertise along with excellent customer service to ensure our customers are able to achieve meadows that are right for them.



MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the practical delivery, establishment and maintenance of planting contracts including meadows, green roofs and sustainable urban drainage.
 - Responsible for reviewing, informing and updating technical information as required
 - Responsible for dealing with customer enquiries and recording data on the Customer Relationship Management system
 - Responsible for customer site visits to carry out survey work, provide advice on planting establishment and maintenance
 - Responsible for preparing customer reports on planting design, establishment, timescales, maintenance and cost
 - Assist in setting an agreed work programme, ensuring that all work is prioritised according to need
 - Responsible for the use and upkeep of machinery and equipment in a good and safe working order
 - Responsible for effective management of staff as required
 - To operate horticultural /agricultural plant, machinery and equipment as required
 - Working at heights as required
 - Driving vehicles and towing trailers across the UK including loading and unloading
 - Involvement in developing new ideas, research and relationships which will continue to keep our commercial landscaping service at the forefront of the landscaping industry
 - Involvement in wider activities such as delivering training and skills sharing which help to build more engaging, adaptive and resilient urban places
 - Completing Health and Safety checks and documents as required
 - Use of Plant Protection Products in accordance with current UK regulations
 - To undertake any other duties that are commensurate with the role and grade of the post

SALARY: Payable salary £23,100.00 - £26,574 per annum.
